Traveler's Agreement – Part One

Trip Terms and Conditions

Trip Dates

December 27, 2026 – January 5, 2027

Company & Legal Entity

This culinary retreat ("Trip") is offered by Nikky Feeding Souls LLC, a Texas Limited Liability Company ("Company"). References to "Chef Nikky" refer to the brand name under which Nikky Feeding Souls LLC operates.

Traveler expressly agrees that all claims, liabilities, and obligations are asserted solely against Nikky Feeding Souls LLC, and not against its owners, members, managers, officers, employees, contractors, or representatives in their individual capacities.

Pricing & Occupancy

- \$12,190 per person (double occupancy)
- Single occupancy: \$18,190

Pricing is based on current supplier costs and currency exchange rates. The Company reserves the right to adjust pricing due to currency fluctuation or supplier cost increases beyond its control.

This Trip requires a minimum number of participants. If the minimum is not met, the Company reserves the right to cancel, modify the itinerary, or adjust pricing.

Payment Schedule

Non-Refundable Deposit

A non-refundable deposit of \$4,690 per person is required at the time of booking to reserve your space.

Extended Payment Plan (Optional)

Guests may choose an extended payment plan for an additional 4% convenience fee, applied to the total trip cost. This fee covers administrative, processing, and financial costs associated with extended payment scheduling and is non-refundable.

Payment Plan Schedule:

- \$3,750 due on or before March 15, 2026
- \$3,750 due on or before July 15, 2026

Failure to submit payments by the stated due dates may result in cancellation of the reservation with forfeiture of all payments made.

Pay-in-Full Option (No Fee)

Guests who pay the full trip balance at booking or by February 15, 2026 may do so without any payment plan convenience fee.

Method of Payment

Payments may be made via Zelle, Venmo (@ChefNikky), or ChefNikky.shop.

Cancellations & Refund Policy

- Deposit is non-refundable under all circumstances
- Cancellation after March 2026 results in forfeiture of all payments made
- No refunds for cancellations within 60 days of departure
- No refunds for missed activities, early departure, or unused services

All cancellations must be submitted in writing and followed with a call or text to Nikky directly at 214-683-2564.

Force Majeure

The Company shall not be liable for delays, cancellations, or modifications caused by events beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, war, civil unrest, pandemics, governmental restrictions, airline disruptions, natural disasters, labor strikes, or border closures.

In such cases, the Company may modify, postpone, or cancel the Trip without liability beyond refunding payments received, less any non-recoverable costs.

What's Included

As outlined in the official itinerary, including accommodations, select meals, internal transportation, activities, guides, and curated experiences.

Not included: international airfare, alcoholic beverages (unless specified), personal expenses, spa services, optional activities, travel insurance or gratuities for guides, drivers, hotel staff, and service providers.

Gratuities are discretionary and based on local customs. A suggested tipping guide will be provided prior to departure for planning purposes.

Travel Insurance (Required)

Traveler must purchase comprehensive travel insurance including medical coverage, emergency evacuation, and trip interruption.

Failure to obtain insurance is at Traveler's own risk.

Medical Fitness & Responsibility

Traveler certifies they are physically, mentally, and medically fit to participate. Traveler is responsible for all medical conditions, medications, and dietary needs.

The Company assumes no responsibility for undisclosed conditions or inability to participate safely.

Travel Documents

Traveler is responsible for obtaining a passport valid at least 6 months beyond return date, visas, and required health documentation. Failure to obtain documentation does not qualify for a refund.

Traveler Conduct & Removal

Unsafe, disruptive, or illegal behavior will not be tolerated. The Company reserves the right to remove any Traveler whose conduct affects safety or group experience. No refunds will be issued in such cases.

Photography & Media Release

Traveler grants the Company the irrevocable right to use photographs, video, voice, and likeness for marketing, promotional, educational, and commercial purposes worldwide, in perpetuity, without compensation.

Traveler's Agreement – Part Two

Assumption of Risk & Release of Liability

Traveler voluntarily assumes all risks associated with international travel, transportation, food experiences, third-party services, illness, injury, loss, or death, and releases the Company to the maximum extent permitted by law.

Traveler's Agreement – Part Three

Governing Law & Venue

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Texas. Any dispute shall be resolved exclusively in Dallas County, Texas.

If any portion is found unenforceable, the remainder shall remain in effect.
